### NOMINATION AND APPLICATION DEADLINES

Spring	October 1st	November 15th
Year	Mid-February	March 1st <i>Accommodation for one year possible in UMONS Campus but application by mid-February at the latest.</i>

### ACADEMIC CALENDAR FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

1st semester	Mid-September to end of January	} Adaptable if necessary
2nd semester	Beginning of February to end of June	
Retake session	End of August or two first weeks of September	

### LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The sending institution, following the agreement signed with our institution, is responsible for providing support to its nominated candidates so that they can have the recommended language skills before the nomination process or teaching period.
